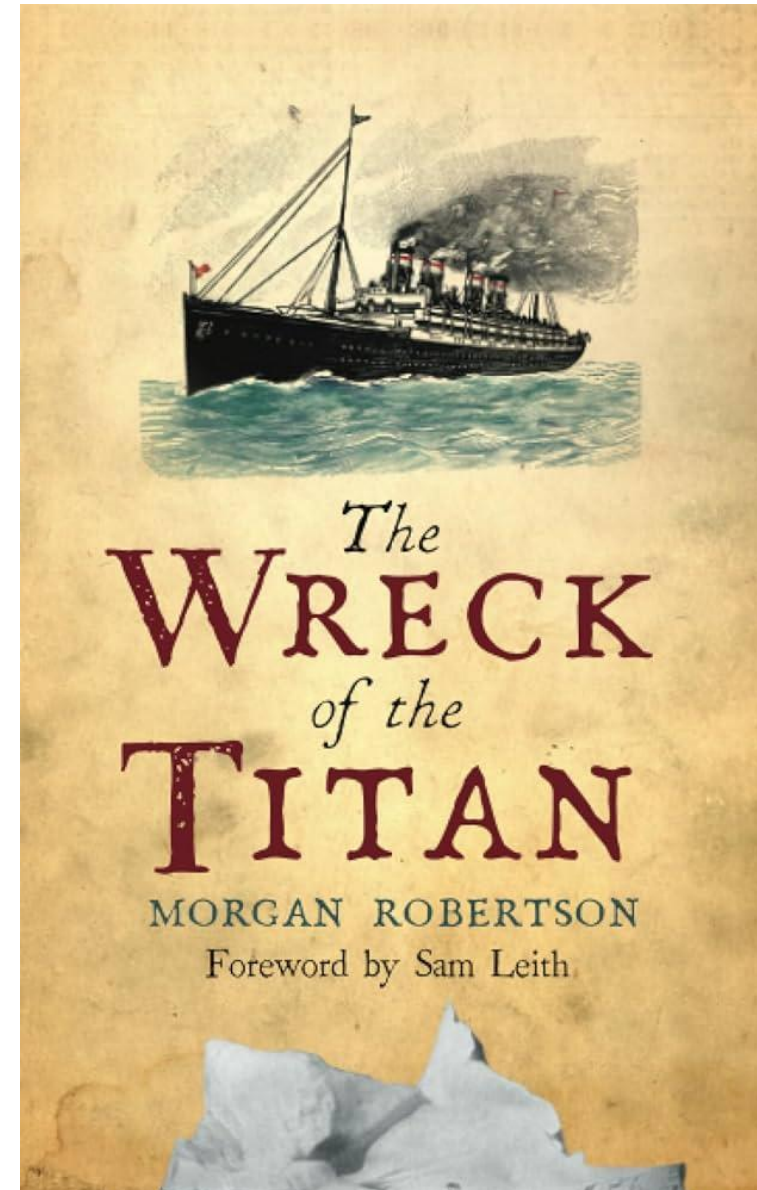




Coincidence = an unexpected and surprising happening of two related events at the same time

You can't believe it (x2)	<i>unbelievable</i> (/ˌʌnbɪˈli:vəbəl/, un-be-LIEVE-able) <i>incredible</i> (/ɪnˈkredəbəl/, in-CRED-ible)
It's not likely	<i>improbable</i> (/ɪmˈprɒbəbəl/, im-PROB-able)
It's not possible	<i>impossible</i> (/ɪmˈpɒsəbəl/, im-POSS-ible)
It didn't sell many copies	<i>unsuccessful</i> (/ˌʌnsəkˈsɛsfəl/, un-suc-CES-ful)
It's not part of the main point	<i>irrelevant</i> (/ɪˈrɛləvənt/, i-REL-e-vant)

 - It's not real. It's unreal.
